CLINICAL HISTORY: Pain; history of running injury

FINDINGS:

The study reveals a focal fluid collection between the soleus and medial head of gastrocnemius, measuring approximately 12 x 2.2 x 6 cm. This shows hyperintense signals on T2W images with subtle hypointense components on gradient-T2 images- findings are suggestive of a hyperacute hematoma. A torn and the retracted plantaris tendon is visualized within the anterior aspect of the collection.

Mild signal changes are seen within the adjoining medial head of gastrocnemius and soleus muscles

The tibia and fibula in view appear unremarkable.

Neurovascular structures appear unremarkable

IMPRESSION:

1. Tears of the plantaris tendon with hyperacute hematoma between the medial head of gastrocnemius and soleus muscles as described.
2. Mild contusions/edema within the adjoining muscle planes.
